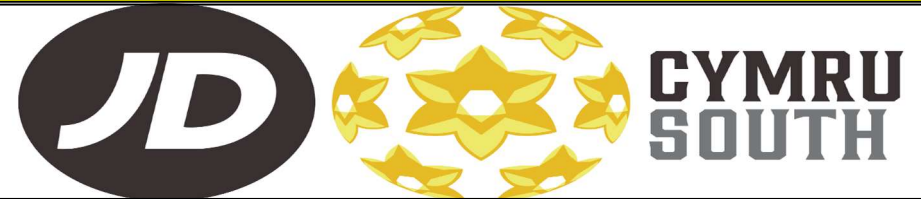

## WELCOME TO CELTIC PARK

We welcome our Gwent neighbours Abergavenny Town to Celtic Park this afternoon. The club was formed in 2014 when Govilon FC changed its name to Abergavenny Town. This followed the sad demise of Abergavenny Thursday, formerly 4 times champions of the Welsh National League who had sunk to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Division of the Gwent County League. There was immediate success for the newly formed club, winning the Gwent County 1<sup>st</sup> Division to gain entry into the Welsh League whereupon they gained promotion the following season to Welsh League Division 2, and, as 2021-22 champions of the new Ardal League South-East, they joined the Cymru South last season finishing one place above the drop zone in 13<sup>th</sup> place.

In last season's games Celtic won all 6 points in the Christmas double header. At Pen-y-pound Celtic were convincing 3-0 winners in a game played in awful rain sodden conditions. Celtic scorers were Alex Bonthron, Tom Meechan and Dominic Connor. In the return at Celtic Park, Town took the lead on 50 minutes but Celtic equalised in the 64<sup>th</sup> minute through a Lewis Iles header and they snatched the points in time added on in time added on through Lewis McCauley after a frantic goalmouth scramble.

This season at Pen-y-Pound it was Town's turn to score a last gasp winner after being behind at the interval. Celtic took an early lead through Lewis Iles but Paolo Marengi equalised and Rhys Schwank scored the winner in time added on from the penalty spot. This was Town's first points of the season ending a run of 5 successive defeats. It is one of only 2 wins bottom-placed Town have achieved this season. Ironically have again lost their last 5 league games – is this an omen for this afternoon?

In goal for Town is a familiar face, Josh Winstone, former Celtic Academy player who made 7 appearances for Celtic last season and who joined Town in January from Merthyr Academy.

## A BRIEF HISTORY OF CWMBRAN CELTIC 1925-2023

Cwmbran Celtic football club was formed in 1925. In the early years the club was known as CYMS (Catholic Young Men's Society). After the immediate success of winning the Newport & District Division 2 Section A title in 1925/6 there was then a 25 year gap before the next trophy, the Premier Division title in 1950/1. The club disbanded in the late 1950's largely as a consequence of national service call-ups but a large influx of junior and youth players brought about the reforming of the club in 1964 under the new name of Cwmbran Catholics. In 1970/1 Celtic won the Gwent Senior Cup. In 1972/3 with playing membership open to all denominations the club dropped the catholic title and re-named as Cwmbran Celtic winning the Gwent Amateur Cup and finishing runners-up in the Gwent Premier League.

In 1979 the club bought its own premises at Oak Street, Old Cwmbran, the club's present headquarters. The club's ground was in Cwmbran Park but around 1995 they moved to the grounds outside Cwmbran Stadium which were shared with Cwmbran Cricket club. The cricket club later moved to Caerleon and Celtic obtained the lease from Torfaen Council.

Celtic played in the Gwent County League in the 1980s and 1990s and after gaining promotion as champions of Division 2 in 1986/7 remained in the 1st division for the next 10 seasons. However a disastrous slide found the club languishing in the 3rd division when Paul "Dishy" Richardson became manager in 1999. He transformed the side bringing in experienced ex-Cwmbran Town stalwarts Mickey Copeman and Kevin Payne alongside teenage striker Shane Williamson who for a dozen seasons was top scorer. The side was later bolstered by the return of ex-professionals Ben Graham and Mark Parfitt who had started their careers with Celtic as juniors. There were successive promotions from the 3rd to 1st division between 1999 and 2001 and in 1999/2000 Celtic won the Gwent County league cup.

In 2004/5 under new player-manager Mickey Copeman, the club were runners-up to Clydach Wasps who applied for membership of the Welsh Football League but their ground was adjudged to be not of the required standard. Celtic applied instead. Their ground was also not up to standard but they were able to share Cwmbran Stadium with Cwmbran Town and the Welsh League accepted the club's application.

In their first season in the WFL, 2005/6, Celtic struggled near the bottom of the 3rd division all season. In April Celtic travelled to Chepstow Town needing a win to stay in the league. They went 1-0 down. With minutes of normal time remaining substitute Jason Price equalised but a draw was not enough. In the 9th minute of time added on player manager Mickey Copeman went up for a corner. The ball was cleared off the goal-line by a Chepstow defender, it hit Copeman on the back and rebounded into the net. Celtic had achieved a last gasp win and, by winning their final match against Seven Sisters, Celtic escaped relegation on goal difference.

The following season, 2006/7, Celtic now back at their upgraded and newly named ground, Celtic Park, were transformed. They only lost 2 games and enjoyed a 24 match unbeaten run. They went to Risca for their last match already promoted but needed to win to secure the Championship ahead of Llanwern. With 3 minutes left Celtic were 1-0 down playing with 10 men after a red card for Kevin Payne. Then Sammy Winter equalised with a speculative long range shot and in the last minute a Risca clearance found full back Ben Graham outside the box.

He hit a perfect looping volley over the goalkeeper's head and into the net. Celtic were champions.

In Division 2 Celtic consolidated their position in 2007/8 and 2008/9 during which they introduced a number of players from their new partnership with Fairwater High School Football Academy in Cwmbran managed by Celtic coach Della Cheedy.

In 2009/10 Celtic were front runners destined to win the Championship. However they lost two key defenders at a crucial time and vital points were dropped. Nevertheless Celtic finished their games in 1st place and would win the title if Penrhiwceiber failed to win at Newcastle Emllyn. The home side was 2-0 up at one stage but Ceiber clawed their way back to win 3-2 and deny Celtic the championship. At the end of the season Mickey Copeman stood down after 7 years during which he secured 3 promotions which took the club from Gwent County League to the top division of the Welsh League.

In their first season in the 1st division, 2010/11 under new manager Ben Graham, Celtic struggled for much of the season and were firmly planted in the relegation zone but a superb run-in during which they won 7 and drew 3 of 14 games earned them 12th place out of 16. In 2011/12 a good start was made under Alan Dibble who stepped down in September with the team in 5th place, to be replaced by Gareth Morgan. Either side of Christmas, Celtic were 2nd but they had a dismal end of season run and again finished 12th.

In 2012/13 with head coach Della Cheedy at the helm, Celtic started brightly with some fine performances including a 4-2 win versus reigning champions Cambrian & Clydach but they lost their way in the New year and at one stage were in last place. However, with characteristic determination they dragged themselves up the table and sealed another season in the top division with a resounding 5 -1 win against Haverfordwest County. Under Steve Morgan in 2013/14 Celtic underperformed finishing 4th from bottom and with Afan Lido relegated from the Welsh Premier League, Celtic were relegated despite appealing to an FAW arbitration. With Della Cheedy back as manager in 2014/15 Celtic finished 7th in Division 2.

In 2015/16 Nicky Church started as manager but he resigned mid-season. Ex Ton Pentre boss Dean Morris took over, won two manager of the month awards, and guided Celtic to the

runners-up position and promotion on the back of 10 straight wins. The club also reached the quarter finals of the Welsh Cup, going down 2-1 after a brave fight at home to WPL side Port Talbot. Josh Bull was the Welsh League's top scorer with 32 league goals.

In 2016/17, back in the 1st Division, Celtic went top of the league early in the season. Dean Morris resigned in March 2017 and first teamer Lee Challenger took over, winning his first 5 games in charge as the team ended in 6th place, their best position in 5 seasons in the top tier.

In 2017/18 Celtic finished 8th in the league and enjoyed their best ever league cup run, reaching the semi-final before losing to Llanelli Town 3-0. Chris Ham was Welsh Division 1 player of the season and top scorer with 28 league goals.

In 2018/19 Celtic finished a disappointing 10th in the League with Lee Challenger resigning in March 2019.

In 2019/20, for the inaugural season of the Cymru League South, Celtic installed Nicky Morgan and Simon Truman as the management team. With 9 new signings there was a lot of optimism for a successful season but the team never got going and after a 6-1 drubbing at Pontypridd in January the club regretfully dismissed the management duo.

Development team manager James Kinsella took over with Matthew Williams as assistant, the team finishing 13th in a curtailed season due to the pandemic.

In 2020/21 only one game was played, in December 2020/21, a 2-0 defeat at Pontypridd Town in the Nathaniel MG League cup.

In 2021/22 having lost key players, Celtic were involved in a basement battle to avoid relegation. Four successive wins late on took them out of the bottom 3 and in the final analysis an equaliser in time added on by Andrew Hewitt saved Celtic and took opponents Risca United down into the Ardal League. Last season Celtic finished a creditable 8th in the table.

## A BRIEF HISTORY OF ABERGAVENNY TOWN

Without doubt the most famous Football Club in Abergavenny was Abergavenny Thursdays whose history can be traced back to the early days of the 20<sup>th</sup>C. Thursday was early closing day for shop workers in Abergavenny and that was when they were able to play football, competing in the Hereford & District Thursday League. Games in the early days were played on the sports fields to the rear of St Michaels RC Church (where St Michaels Rd is now), players changed in the Butcher's Arms Public House (now demolished), this probably is where one of the Clubs' nicknames "The Butchers" comes from.

Post WW2, Thursdays played in Bailey Park to large crowds, and joined the Welsh Football League. The need for a permanent Football Stadium was recognized and the Clubs Directors set about developing Pen-y-Pound Stadium, opening in 1953, the playing surface was one of the largest in Wales. Often referred to as the "Welsh Wembley". Abergavenny Thursdays were Welsh League champions in 1958/59, 1959/60, 1990/91 and 1991/92.

1992 saw them become founder members of the Konica League of Wales (now JD Cymru Premier League). However, this was only short lived and they were relegated back to the Welsh League after just one season, unfortunately the good times never returned to Pen-y-Pound and after falling into the Gwent County League (Div3), Thursdays withdrew in August 2013, citing a lack of players as the reason, and subsequently folded, although Abergavenny Thursdays Trust still remains administering Pen-y-Pound Stadium.

Most village communities around Abergavenny also host local football teams and Govilon AFC began over 100yrs ago. Playing mainly at District level throughout that time, they won the Gwent Central League gaining admittance to the Gwent County League in 2007/08. They climbed rapidly through the divisions to Div1 winning both the Gwent Amateur Cup and Gwent County Challenge Cup on the way. Difficulties with the local Community Council and unable to progress further up the Welsh Pyramid system at their village ground, Govilon took the decision to move into Pen-y-Pound for 2013/14 following the Thursdays demise. Finishing that season in a creditable 5<sup>th</sup> place. For 2014/15 the club changed its name to Abergavenny Town FC, quickly building an excellent fan base by producing an outstanding standard of football winning the Gwent County League Div1 after dropping only two league points all season and reaching the Semi-final stage of the FAW Trophy.

Gaining entrance to the Nathaniel Cars Welsh League for 2015/16 season, Town continued to progress and after a hard fought promotion battle between Pontypridd Town (winners), Abergavenny Town and Bridgend Street FC which went right down to the final week of the season, Town ended in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, gaining further promotion to Div2 for 2016/17. Town also went one better and after defeating Sully Sports 1-0 in the final played at Dragon Park Newport, won the FAW Trophy to complete another memorable season.

In conjunction with the Thursdays Trust, "Town" continues to improve and revitalize Pen-y-Pound Stadium bringing the Old Lady" as some affectionately call the ground, back to the standards of old.

In recent years we have made major improvements to the changing rooms, installed 280 seats, carried out refurbishments to the club house and are looking to reinstate the spectator toilet facilities. Plans are in place to bring the iconic grandstand back up to standard in the near future.

Having achieved FAW Tier3 status, "Town" were proud to be founder members of the new Ardal Leagues and looked to continue to progress within the FAW Pyramid system. Following the temporary cessation of organized football due to Covid 19 shutdown, "Town" finished season 2021/22 as Ardal Southeast League Champions and with the awarding of an FAW Tier2 grading to Pen-y-Pound Stadium, were promoted to the JD Cymru South League for 2022/23 season.

The Club presently field sides in JD Cymru, FAW Reserve, FAW Youth and also an Under 16's team. Plans are to introduce junior teams from U6 up to U16's. It is hoped that a youth Academy will be formed in the near future.

Celtic went into this game at Celtic Park with high hopes of re-producing a shock result against 2<sup>nd</sup> placed Ferry to match their recent triumph against leaders Llanelli Town & they were on course at half-time having taken the lead on 45 minutes when Alex Bonthron was on the end of a Iwan Hooper clearance to lob Celtic into a half-time lead. This after Callum Hodges had to withdraw having collapsed with a nasty leg injury when making a clearance.

Ferry equalised in the 63<sup>rd</sup> minute when a cross from the right a headed across goal for defender Kris Evans to score. And then, on 74 minutes, Ferry took the lead in controversial circumstances. Andrew Larcombe & a Ferry attacker both went down in a clash on the edge of the penalty box – a clear 50/50 but the referee gave a penalty which Luke Bowen converted. Celtic pressed for the equaliser and were rewarded on 90+1 when Lewis Iles forced the ball home at the near post from Josh Hinwood’s first time cross from the left. Ferry were not going to surrender however and they scored twice in the closing minutes through Walters and Demery to keep their challenge for the title on course.

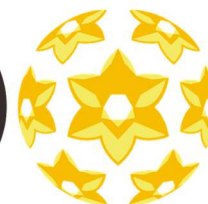
