

CLUB CARE AND PROTECTION (SAFEGUARDING)OFFICER

Listed below are the main duties of the club's Care and Protection (Safeguarding) Officer:-

If anyone (player or parent) has any issues which fall within these areas and which cannot be resolved by your Team Manager, these should be referred to the club's Care and Protection (Safeguarding) Officer. If they are unable to find a satisfactory resolution, then the matter will be referred to the Club's Management Committee for further consideration.

- Administer the DBS (formerly CRB) programme throughout the club in both juniors and seniors .
- Ensure that coaches and relevant personnel have current and valid DBS checks .
- Ensure that coaches and relevant personnel have the necessary coaching qualifications to undertake their roles.
- Ensure that the club meets at least the Standard level of the Club Accreditation Programme (in partnership with club colleagues)
- Act as the point of contact for-safeguarding/welfare issues at club level and liaises with local agencies where necessary .
- Implement best practice at club level.
- Has a duty of care and protection to all children and adults associated with the club .
- Must hold the FAW safeguarding award (3 years)
