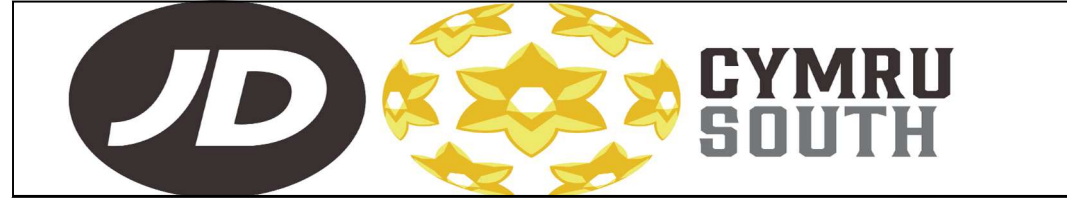

## WELCOME TO CELTIC PARK

This afternoon we welcome Aberystwyth Town to Celtic Park, their first visit to play our boys in Cwmbran for 55 years having last played us in Celtic Park in 1970/1 in a 4<sup>th</sup> round replay in the Welsh Amateur Cup. Town, then in the Mid Wales League, were the reigning cup holders but in the game at their place, Cwmbran Catholics, as they were then known, went two goals up through goals by Dave Rix and Mike Couzens. A big shock looked on the cards but the home side clawed their way back and scraped a 2-2 draw with two goals in the closing minutes. The Catholics lost 3-1 in the replay at Cwmbran Park before 400 spectators.

Town were relegated from the Welsh Premier League last season after 33 years in the top tier having been in it since its inception in 1993-4 when Cwmbran Town were the inaugural winners.

Town and Celtic met at Park Avenue in September and Town won 2-0. They are currently on a role, lying in 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the Cymru South League having won 5 and drawn one of their last league 6 games. They are 12 points behind second-placed Trefelin BGC who, along with 1<sup>st</sup> placed Cambrian United and Aberystwyth are all striving to obtain a licence to gain promotion to the Premier League next season.

## A BRIEF HISTORY OF CWMBRAN CELTIC 1925-2025

Cwmbran Celtic Football Club was formed in 1925. In the early years the club was known as CYMS (Catholic Young Men's Society). After the immediate success of winning the Newport & District Division 2 Section A title in 1925/26 there was then a 25-year gap before the next trophy, the Premier Division title in 1950/51. The club disbanded in the late 1950s largely as a consequence of national service call-ups but an influx of junior and youth players brought about the re-forming of the club in 1964 under the new name Cwmbran Catholics. In 1970/71 Celtic won the Gwent Senior Cup. In 1972/73 with playing membership open to all denominations the club dropped the catholic title and re-named as Cwmbran Celtic winning the Gwent Amateur Cup and finishing runners-up in the Gwent Premier League. In 1979 the club bought its own premises at Oak Street, Old Cwmbran, the club's present headquarters. The club's ground was in Cwmbran Park but around 1995 they moved to the grounds outside Cwmbran Stadium which were shared with Cwmbran Cricket club. The cricket club later moved to Caerleon and Celtic obtained the lease from Torfaen Council.

Celtic played in the Gwent County League in the 1980s and 1990s and after gaining promotion as champions of Division 2 in 1986/87 they remained in the 1st division for the next 10 seasons. However a disastrous slide found the club languishing in the 3rd division when Paul "Dishy" Richardson became manager in 1999. He transformed the side bringing in experienced ex-Cwmbran Town stalwarts Mickey Copeman and Kevin Payne alongside teenage striker Shane Williamson who for a dozen seasons was top scorer. The side was later bolstered by the return of ex-professionals Ben Graham and Mark Parfitt who had started their careers with Celtic as juniors. There were successive promotions from the 3rd to 1st division between 1999 and 2001 and in 1999/2000 Celtic won the Gwent County league cup.

In 2004/05 under new player-manager Mickey Copeman, the club were runners-up to Clydach Wasps who applied for membership of the Welsh Football League but their ground was adjudged to be not of the required standard. Celtic applied instead. Their ground was also not up to standard but they were shared Cwmbran Stadium with Cwmbran Town and the Welsh League accepted the club's application.

In their first season in the WFL, 2005/06, Celtic struggled near the bottom of the 3rd division all season. In April they travelled to Chepstow Town needing a win to stay in the league. They went 1-0 down. With minutes of normal time remaining substitute Jason Price equalised but a draw was not enough. In the 9th minute of time added on player manager Mickey Copeman went up for a corner. The ball was cleared off the goal-line by a Chepstow defender, it hit Copeman on the back and rebounded into the net. Celtic had achieved a last gasp win and, by winning their final match against Seven Sisters, Celtic escaped relegation on goal difference.

The following season, 2006/07, Celtic, now back at their upgraded and newly named ground, Celtic Park, were transformed. They only lost two games and enjoyed a 24-match unbeaten run. They went to Risca for their last match already promoted but needed to win to secure the Championship ahead of Llanwern. With three minutes left Celtic were 1-0 down playing with 10 men after a red card for Kevin Payne. Then Sammy Winter equalised with a speculative long range shot and in the last minute a Risca clearance found full back Ben Graham outside the box. He hit a perfect looping volley over the goalkeeper's head and into the net. Celtic were champions.

In Division 2 Celtic consolidated their position in 2007/08 and 2008/09 during which they introduced a number of players from their new partnership with Fairwater High School Football Academy in Cwmbran managed by Celtic coach Della Cheedy. In 2009/10 Celtic were front runners destined to win the Championship. However they lost two key defenders at a crucial

time and vital points were dropped. Nevertheless Celtic finished their games in 1st place and would win the title if Penrhiwceiber failed to win at Newcastle Emlyn. The home side was 2-0 up at one stage but Ceiber clawed their way back to win 3-2 and deny Celtic the championship. At the end of the season Mickey Copeman stood down after seven years during which he secured three promotions which took the club from Gwent County League to the top division of the Welsh League.

In their first season in the 1st division, 2010/11 under new manager Ben Graham, Celtic struggled for much of the season and were firmly planted in the relegation zone but a superb run-in during which they won seven and drew three of 14 games earned them 12th place out of 16. In 2011/12 a good start was made under Alan Dibble who stepped down in September with the team in 5th place, to be replaced by Gareth Morgan. Either side of Christmas, Celtic were 2nd but they had a dismal end of season run and again finished 12th.

In 2012/13 with head coach Della Cheedy at the helm, Celtic started brightly with some fine performances including a 4-2 win versus reigning champions Cambrian & Clydach but they lost their way in the New year and at one stage were in last place. However, with characteristic determination they dragged themselves up the table and sealed another season in the top division with a resounding 5-1 win against Haverfordwest County. Under Steve Morgan in 2013/14 Celtic underperformed finishing 4th from bottom and with Afan Lido relegated from the Welsh Premier League, Celtic were relegated despite appealing to an FAW arbitration. With Della Cheedy back as manager in 2014/15 Celtic finished 7th in Division 2.

In 2015/16 Nicky Church started as manager but he resigned mid-season. Ex Ton Pentre boss Dean Morris took over, won two manager of the month awards, and guided Celtic to the runners-up position and promotion on the back of 10 straight wins. The club also reached the quarter finals of the Welsh Cup, going down 2-1 after a brave fight at home to WPL side Port Talbot. Josh Bull was the Welsh League's top scorer with 32 league goals.

In 2016/17, back in the 1st Division, Celtic went top of the league early in the season. Dean Morris resigned in March 2017 and first teamer Lee Challenger took over, winning his first five games in charge as the team ended in 6th place, their best position in five seasons in the top tier. In 2017/18 Celtic finished 8th in the league and enjoyed their best ever league cup run, reaching the semi-final before losing to Llanelli Town 3-0. Chris Ham was Welsh Division 1 player of the season and top scorer with 28 league goals. In 2018/19 Celtic finished a disappointing 10th in the League with Lee Challenger resigning in March 2019.

In 2019/20, for the inaugural season of the Cymru League South, Celtic installed Nicky Morgan and Simon Truman as the management team. With nine new signings there was a lot of optimism for a successful season but the team never got going and after a 6-1 drubbing at Pontypridd in January the club regretfully dismissed the management duo. Development team manager James Kinsella took over with Matthew Williams as assistant, the team finishing 13th in a curtailed season due to the pandemic.

In 2020/21, because of the covid pandemic only one game was played, a 2-0 defeat at Pontypridd Town in the Nathaniel MG League cup. In 2021/22 having lost key players, Celtic were involved in a basement battle to avoid relegation. Four successive wins late on took them out of the bottom three and an equaliser in time added on by Andrew Hewitt saved Celtic and took opponents Risca United down into the Ardal League. In 2022/23 Celtic finished 8<sup>th</sup>. In 2023/24 they finished 10<sup>th</sup> Alex Botnrhon won the Cymru South Golden Boot with 30 goals. Last season, in the club's centenary season, under new manager Simon Berry, Celtic lost several key players including Alex Bonthron during the season, but Simon recruited a number of young replacements and the team beat Llantwit Major on the last day of the season to finish 13<sup>th</sup> and avoid relegation.

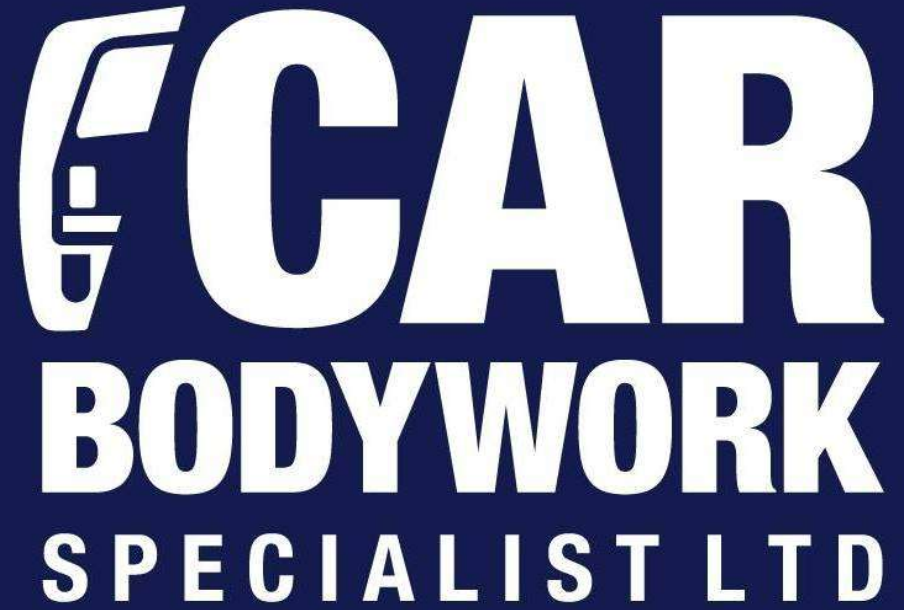

## A BRIEF HISTORY ABERYSTWYTH TOWN

Founded in 1884, Aberystwyth Town Football Club has been a pillar of the Welsh football community for over a century. Our home ground, Park Avenue, has witnessed countless memorable moments and has been the backdrop for numerous achievements, including our historic Welsh Cup victory in 1900, where we became the first team from mid-Wales to secure the trophy.

Although Aberystwyth Town FC was formed in 1884, the club probably existed in the 1870s in an earlier incarnation - the re-establishment of a "town" club is recorded in 1876. Their early days were marked by friendly matches and it was not until 1896 that the club first joined a league - the Welsh League.

After only one season they reverted to playing friendly matches but were firmly on the map in 1900, convincingly beating fancied Druids 3-0 in the Welsh Cup final and becoming the first team from West Wales to take the trophy. But this Welsh Cup victory almost proved to be their downfall as they hit a massive financial crisis and a mass exodus of players.

Aber's league career has a nomadic flavour, as they have been members of various leagues since they entered the first competition, the Welsh League, in 1896. That foray lasted only one season and they returned to playing friendly fixtures but did enter the English FA Cup on a few occasions. With interest in the club rekindled, they joined the "Combination" but again for only one term, probably because of the expense of travelling.

Aber were members of the Montgomeryshire & District League from 1904, winning several championships, and with the advent of the Welsh National League in 1921 joined the Central Section. The club was very successful in the 1920s - achieving six title wins - and took the Mid-Wales League title in 1933 and 1950. Aber won the Welsh Amateur Cup in 1931 and 1933 and were finalists in 1935 and 1972.

The club began a long stay in the Welsh League (South) in 1951, although they continued to also field a team in the Mid-Wales League, and for a time in the Cambrian Coast League. They eventually returned to mid-Wales competition in 1963 but did not win the league championship until 1984, after finishing as runners-up on six occasions. They retained the title the following season, both under team boss Meirion Appleton.

After their two nil-nil draws and a spirited performance in losing by just 2 goals to one against Cambrian United, Celtic recovered from two early goals to be just 2-1 down against the league leaders Trefelin at half-time. However, the wheels came off in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half after Isaac Powell was red-carded and Celtic slumped to their worst ever defeat in the Welsh League/Cymru South era. The visitors opened the scoring in the 10<sup>th</sup> minute with a break down the middle with Lewys Ware lobbing the retreating Celtic defence to put Tyler Brock in to score. Trefelin were two up after 15 minutes when Brock scored his 2<sup>nd</sup> from the penalty spot after a foul in the 18-yard box. On 28 minutes Celtic pulled a goal back when Oliver Berry's free kick was blocked by the Trefelin wall and fell to Alex McDowell who slammed the ball home. Trefelin had three more chances before half time which all went wide. Trefelin were 3-1 up on 50 minutes when two headers forward found Brock who somehow ghosted his way past two defenders and raced towards the goal before rounding Hooper to score his hat-trick goal. A minute later Celtic were reduced to 10 men when Isaac Powell and Jordan Davies jostled each other. Davies hit the deck and Isaac was sent off for a second yellow whilst Davies received no punishment. Celtic added two more goals in quick succession. Fist Callum Saunders crossed from the right for Brock to score from close range at the near post. Then the Saunders-Brock combination worked again for Brock to score his 5<sup>th</sup> goal. In the 83<sup>rd</sup> minute Jasper Jones scored from outside the penalty box and Trefelin added two more in time added on – a ball headed forward for Jasper Jones to score his second goal and a long ball from the left only half cleared by the Celtic defence for Saunders with all the time in the world to turn and score.

Celtic had a great opportunity to reduce the arrears when Cole Doolan's shot from distance was parried by keeper Dimonkene straight to Jac Evans who looked certain to score in front of goal, but the keeper reacted to get his foot in the way of the goal bound shot and Andrew Larcombe following up could only place the ball over the bar. Into the 2<sup>nd</sup> half and on 64 minutes Celtic reduced the arrears when a free kick from Iwan Hooper was headed across the Lido goal by John Hall straight to Tom Dean who scored with a header. The hosts restored their 2-goal lead in the 73<sup>rd</sup> minute when a cross from the right was played forward by Hanbury to Griffiths to steer the ball into the corner of the net. With the last attack of the game Lido scored their 4<sup>th</sup> goal when, from a cross by 10, Griffiths headed the ball goalwards where Cameron Keetch's head beat Hooper's attempted punch to find the net and secure Lido's 4<sup>th</sup> successive win in their late season revival. 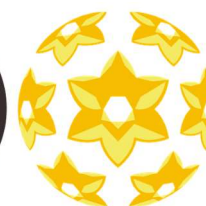
